**REMEMBER:** this is a shared trip with our friends in the KC Ski Club, and bring your aspirin – THIS IS A PARTY!!

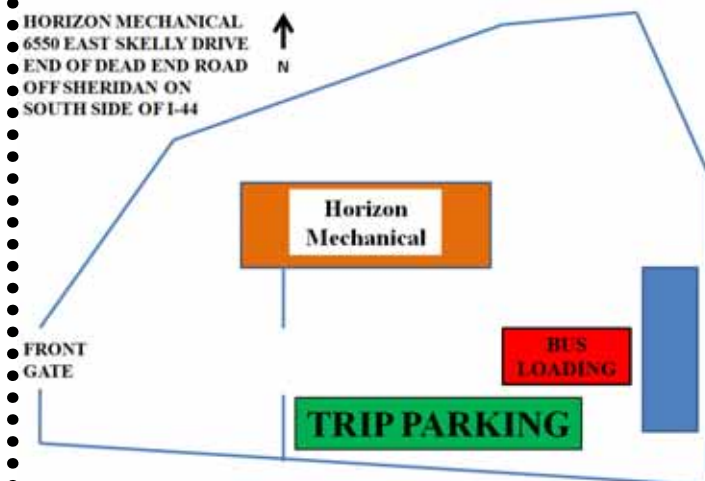

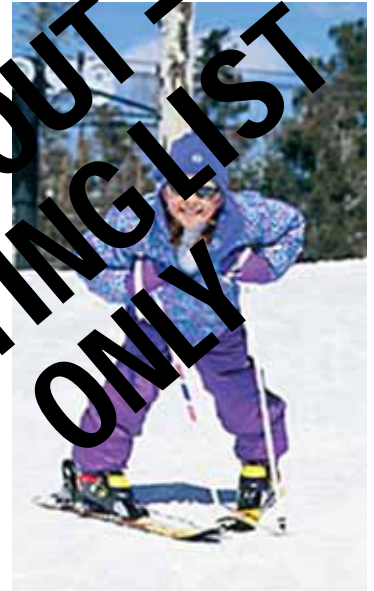
