## President's Column

### MAINTAINING A CONSISTANT ORGANIZATION EVEN THOUGH THINGS ARE CHANGING IN OUR SKI CLUB

Our club is prospering. Ski trips are full and organized. Twenty-three percent of our skiers take more than one trip. Many new members, whether skiers or not, are enjoying social activities. But there are other things changing in our internal organization.



The main change every year is a new Board of Directors. This may be why we are adapting and restructuring.

Board meetings have been considerably shortened in past three years – 1 or 1 ½ hours. A fast paced agenda, as well as using email for pre-discussion and occasional voting, has reduced time-consuming discussions. It's amazing that when we adjourn early, board members hang around socializing, enjoying one another's company and hospitality.

We eliminated the Audit Committee four years ago, mostly because we now have a Trip Assistant collecting the money instead of Trip Captains. Bylaw changes come slow. Last changes were 2001.

The Winter Trip Chairman's job is easier now. Pressure was reduced when the Trip Assistant's job was added. Then, this year a meeting of experienced members and captains offered to jump start the ski plans. Because Flatlands date and location was fixed, I planned the FSA lodging last year before becoming president.

The primary task for **Bruce** as new Trip Chairman was the remaining trips planning, captains, and lodging arrangements. This year, club Secretary **Fred Hegenbart** accepted responsibility of negotiating Kincaid bus agreements. Experienced Captains **John Hill, Don Woolsey, Phil Wiltfong, Bill Obermark** and **Terry Nichols** helped custom-plan their own trips. **Bruce's** wife **Paula** helped immensely with details.

Two years ago we didn't publish trip prices on our website. Now, we advertise trips and prices on the website and in the newspaper without fear of audit. An audit in 1984 charged we should not do business with the general public, including advertising, because we are a tax exempt corporation. IRS concluded the Tulsa Ski Club offers social and recreational activities in a manner distinguishable from the general public because we require membership upon joining a trip.

Future positive changes will better our ski club. We need both new and experienced volunteers for the Board of Directors.

Our nominating committee is meeting now to select the next Board of Directors, which begins May 1, 2008. Please volunteer for one of the fourteen board member positions. Ask for a job description of a position that interests you. Consider how important it is to give back to the club that has provided friends and fun opportunities to you and your family.

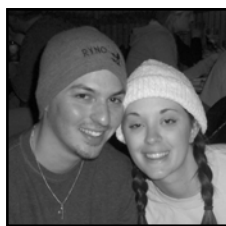


to go, **Larry!** Speaking of medals, **Gabrielle Watts** on her third time skiing won a
