Flatlands 2013 trip to Aspen Snowmass, CO

ASPEN  SNOWMASS.

If you want to go on the Flatlands trip to Snowmass in January, sign up before November 23! That's the date the club must decide whether to take two buses or one and whether to cancel any lodging.

Every year ski clubs in Oklahoma, Kansas, Missouri, and Nebraska meet for a week of friendly competition and fun. The event is hosted by the Flatlands Ski Association and the annual trip is called Flatlands. This year's trip is to Aspen Snowmass – one of the premiere resorts in North America, a destination featuring four ski mountains, the quaint ski town of Aspen (home to the stars), and a huge mountain village filled with restaurants and shopping.

The history of Flatlands dates way back and has become a tradition of our club. Again this year we have reserved two buses and lodging for 102 people.

What's different this year is that we can't wait until the last minute for people to sign up. The contract isn't as flexible as in previous years, and the cancellation penalties are high. It's no surprise that some big dollars are at stake regarding penalties.

The number of people who sign up for this trip is always way behind what our numbers need to be for what we calculate. It is difficult to make it possible for everyone to go on the trip who wants to go while also minimizing financial risk of cancellation penalties.

OUR MOST CRUCIAL DEADLINE IS NOVEMBER 23.

We have to know on November 23 how many people plan to go on the trip. On that date we will have to decide whether to take only one bus and cancel the second. We will also have to decide how many rooms to cancel.

We know it's difficult to plan this far in advance. As a Board we have to take action and act responsibly to prevent our exposure to any loss of money for cancellation penalties. We have got great lodging reserved at The Terrace House in the Snowmass Village, and any travel to this area will provide plenty of activity even for people that don't ski. Right now we have enough lodging reserved to accommodate 102 people and transportation for 80. This arrangement in rooming provides us with flexibility for those that don't want to ride the bus. Come enjoy, participate, and cheer along with the rest of our ski club members.

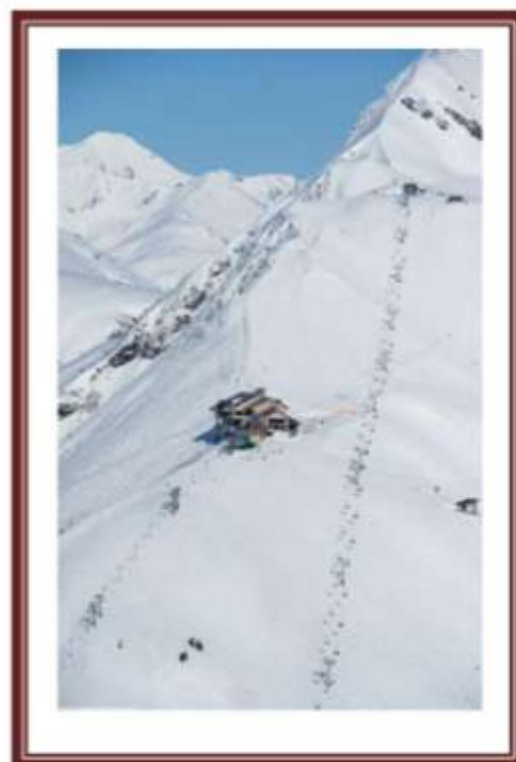

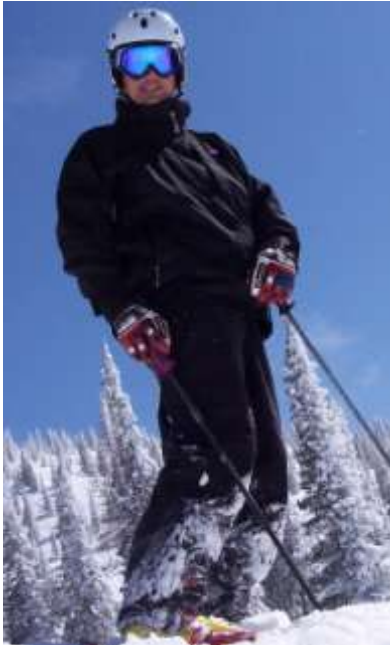
